

FS04 Safety SBC Socketed Evaluation Board

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The FS0400SKTEVM is the socketed evaluation board (EVB) for the FS04 Power Management Integrated Circuit (PMIC). It integrates a 64-pin quad flat no-lead (QFN) socket that allows users to easily insert and test FS04 devices. The board also includes a communication bridge based on the FRDM-KL25Z development platform, enabling seamless connection to the FS04 graphical user interface (GUI) software to configure the device and program the one-time programmable (OTP) registers.

The FS0400SKTEVM contains all the hardware required to functionally evaluate FS04 configurations before performing the final OTP programming, making it ideal for development, validation and pre-production testing.
