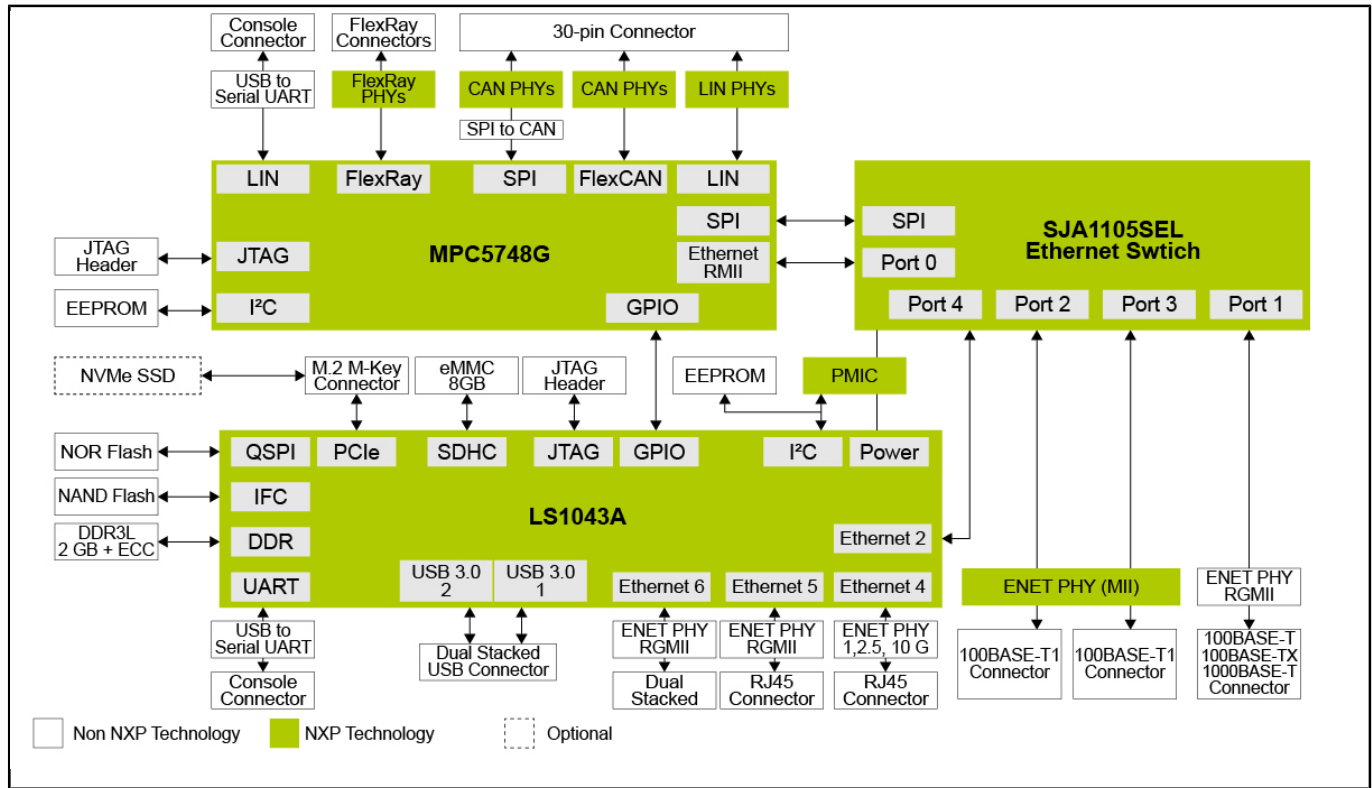

The MPC-LS-VNP-RDB integrates standards-based, open source software with feature-rich hardware for establishing a common and open framework for secure service delivery within a vehicle network.
