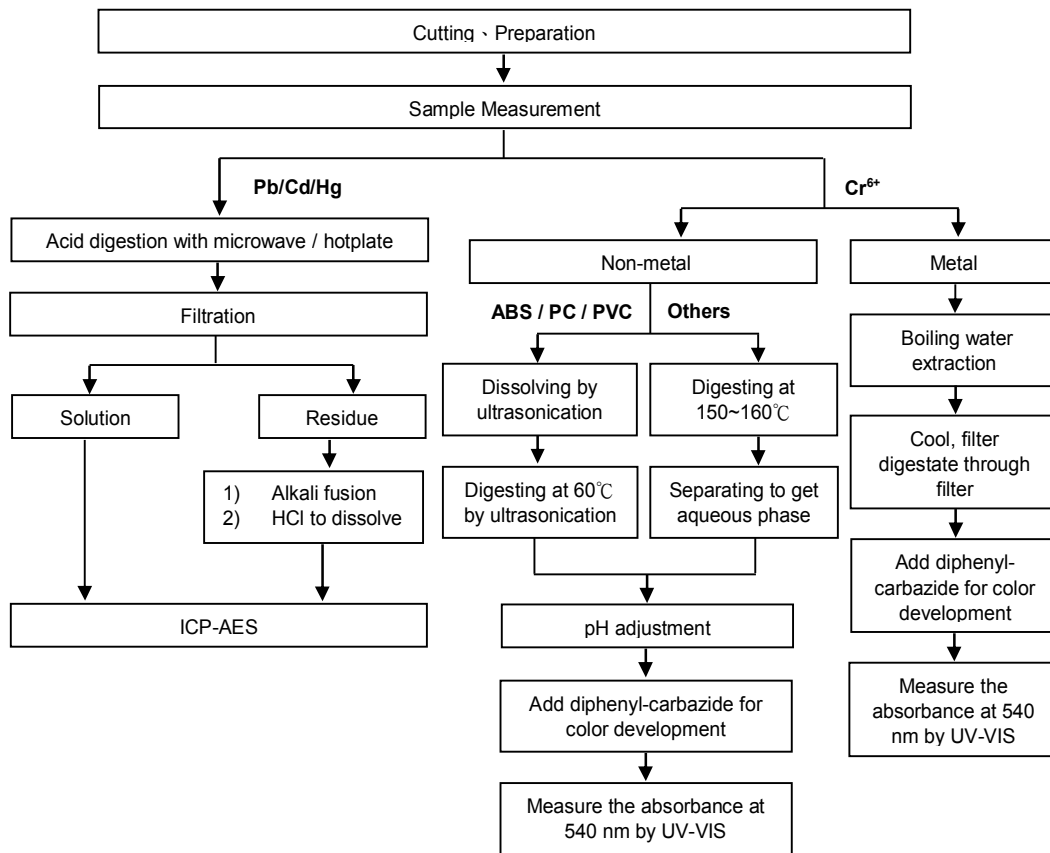

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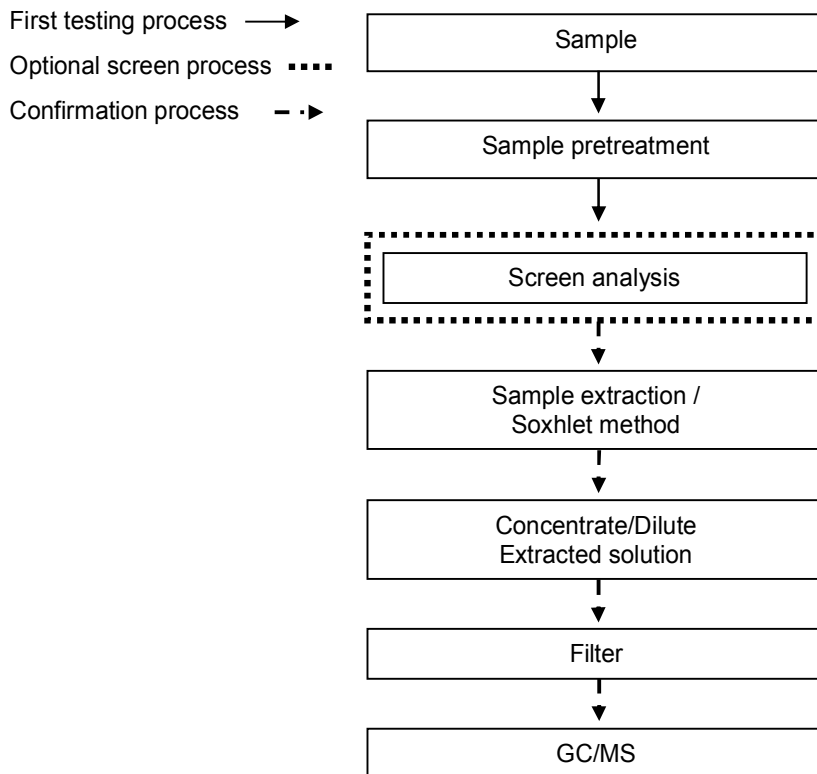
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Analytical flow chart – PBB / PBDE

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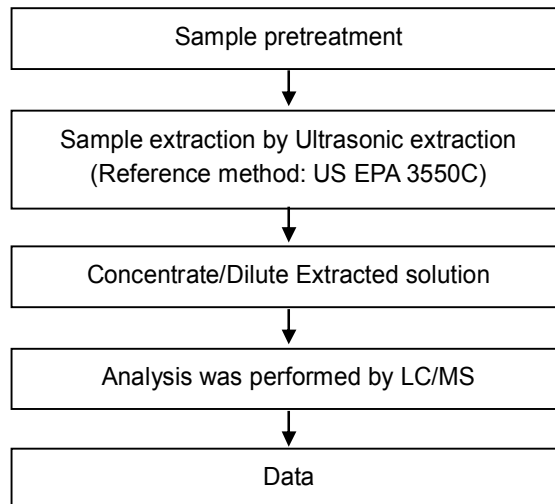
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Analytical flow chart - PFOA/PFOS

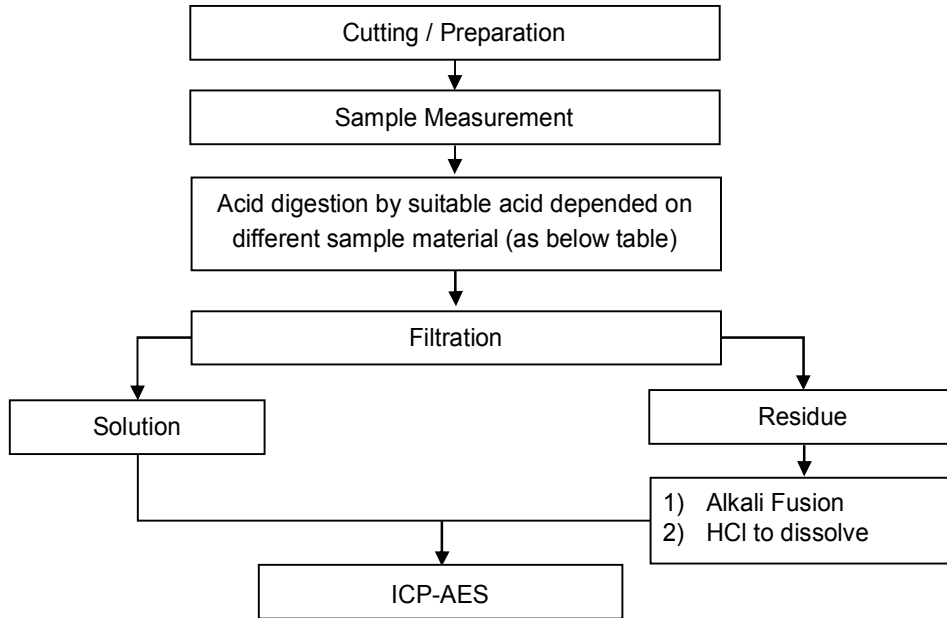

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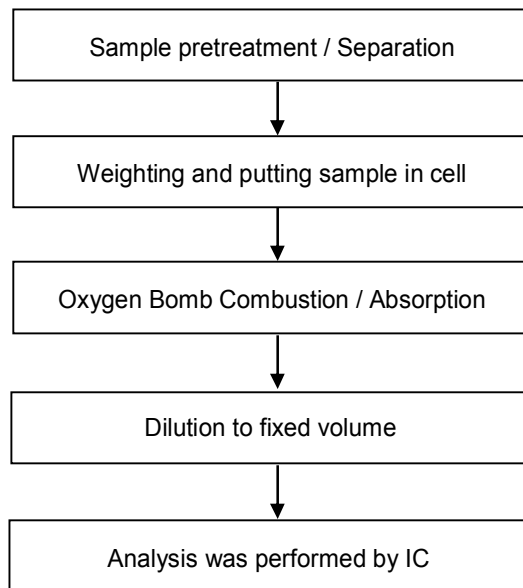
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Analytical flow chart - Halogen

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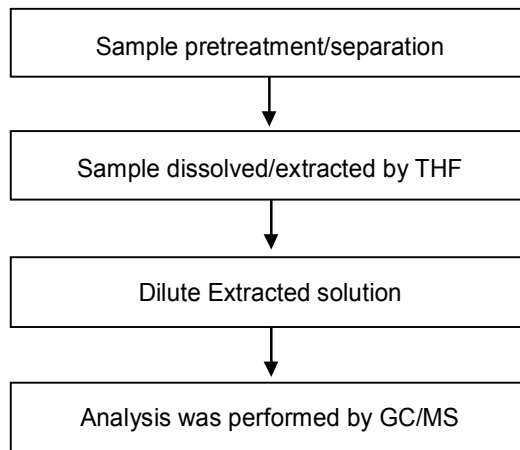
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Analytical flow chart - Phthalate
